MUNICIPAL ELECTRIC UTILITIES RECOGNIZED FOR SAFETY ACHIEVEMENTS

SUN PRAIRIE, WIS. – Thirty-five of Wisconsin’s public power utilities were recognized for their outstanding safety achievements from Municipal Electric Utilities of Wisconsin (MEUW). Each utility received an award in recognition of its commitment and dedication to establishing a strong safety culture.

“MEUW’s Safety Achieving Awards are designed to recognize leading indicators, rather than lagging indicators of safety performance. It is very easy to put incidents and injuries in the forefront when measuring safety success, but the MEUW Safety Awards are designed to highlight the proactive approaches utilities are taking to create a stronger safety culture,” said Mike Czuprynko, Manager of Safety Services at MEUW.

An application process was developed by MEUW with specific questions that relate to actions utilities are taking to create a strong safety culture. Utilities that apply and qualify receive a score that is then categorized by bronze, silver, and gold levels.
