

## MEUW member utilities recognized among America's safest public power companies

Ten Wisconsin municipal utilities have earned the American Public Power Association's (APPA) Safety Award of Excellence for safe operating practices in 2022. The utilities earned awards for having the fewest worker-hours of annual worker exposure.

More than 250 utilities entered the annual Safety Awards for 2022. Entrants were placed in categories according to their number of worker-hours and ranked based on the most incident-free records and overall state of their safety programs and culture during 2022. The incidence rate is based on the number of work-related reportable injuries or illnesses and the number of worker-hours during 2022, as defined by OSHA, the federal Occupational Safety and Health Administration.
