



## WWTP OPERATOR

The Black River Falls Municipal Utilities (BRFMU) is accepting applications for the position of Waste Water Treatment Plant Operator. This full-time position reports directly to the WWTP Lead Operator and will perform technical, skilled, and manual work. Primary responsibilities include the efficient and effective control, monitoring, operation, maintenance, and repair of the municipal WWTP and lift stations. Other duties will include performing process and regulatory related lab testing in accordance with standard methods and regulatory requirements, interpreting lab results, making necessary adjustments to treatment systems, and accurate record keeping and reporting.

Successful candidates will possess a high school diploma or equivalent, a technical college degree with a water resources or science discipline, or an equivalent combination of education and experience; a thorough knowledge of the safety protocols and occupational hazards of the trade, mechanical aptitude, excellent communication and customer service skills, experience with Microsoft Office applications, and the ability to think critically and problem solve. Preferred candidates will possess a certified WDNR Wastewater licensure. The selected candidate will be required to obtain all necessary wastewater certifications within two (2) years of the date of hire, expected to obtain pertinent WDNR Water certifications within a reasonable period of time established by BRFMU, and be subject to a six (6) month probationary period. This position requires on-call duty and weekend work on a rotational basis, the ability to respond to work within 30 minutes, and a valid WI driver's license. A pre-employment drug/alcohol screen and physical will be required. This position is represented by the General Teamsters Union Local 662 bargaining unit. New hires will be required to enroll in health insurance coverage through BRFMU's health insurance provider Central States Team Care.

Starting compensation is \$21.34-\$27.43 per hour DOQ, with an excellent benefits package. Selected candidate can increase to full wage within two (2) years with satisfactory job performance.
