Work involves direct responsibility for planning, organizing, scheduling, and coordinating all utility services activities, electric distribution construction, projects, street lighting, maintenance, and other activities. Work also includes resolving customer service problems and reliability issues. Supervision over employees in the Electric Department. Work is performed under the supervision of the General Manager and is reviewed through conferences and reports.

Utility fleet management responsibilities include purchasing, administration, operation, and maintenance oversight of fleet vehicles at the office complex and other off-site facilities.

Utility services responsibilities include the coordination, administration, operation, and maintenance of the office and operations facility and other off-site facilities with a basic understanding of various types of construction methods and practices, heating, ventilation, air conditioning systems and building management controls and software.

The candidate must have considerable knowledge of the methods, procedures, construction standards (including OH and URD line construction), maintenance, repair and operations for electric distribution components, electric metering, vehicles, equipment, and materials.
